KZAX: New Leadership, Same Awesome Local Support

KZAX is one part of Make.Shift Art Space, a non-profit "maker's space" founded in 2008. Its first projects provided biodiesel vans to gigging bands and bike-generators for outdoor shows. Then, in 2011, a move into recently vacated space allowed the organization to expand. Today, Make.Shift offers 21 studios at affordable rental rates to visual artists and musicians, curates an art gallery, operates a performance space, and, since 2016, owns and manages KZAX.
