

# Pacifica Network Welcomes WLTL: A Station Forever Young & Forever Renewed

Sometime toward the end of the 1967 school year, two juniors at Lyons Township High School in La Grange, Illinois, requested a meeting with the District Superintendent. They had an idea that the school should establish its own radio station, in-house and student-run...Today, that station is not only the voice of its La Grange community, a community some 150,000 strong, but also a successful educational project.

General Manager Chris Thomas explains, "It's kind of fun to say it's really been a student-led effort from the get-go here at WLTL...Fifty years later, we've one hundred plus students involved, doing podcasting, doing live radio shows, doing music reviews, blog writing, I mean things that the founders never could have imagined existed back in 1968....And that seems weird when you think
